low-cost, and nationally relevant MRV system tailored specifically for the needs of Canada's agri-food sector.

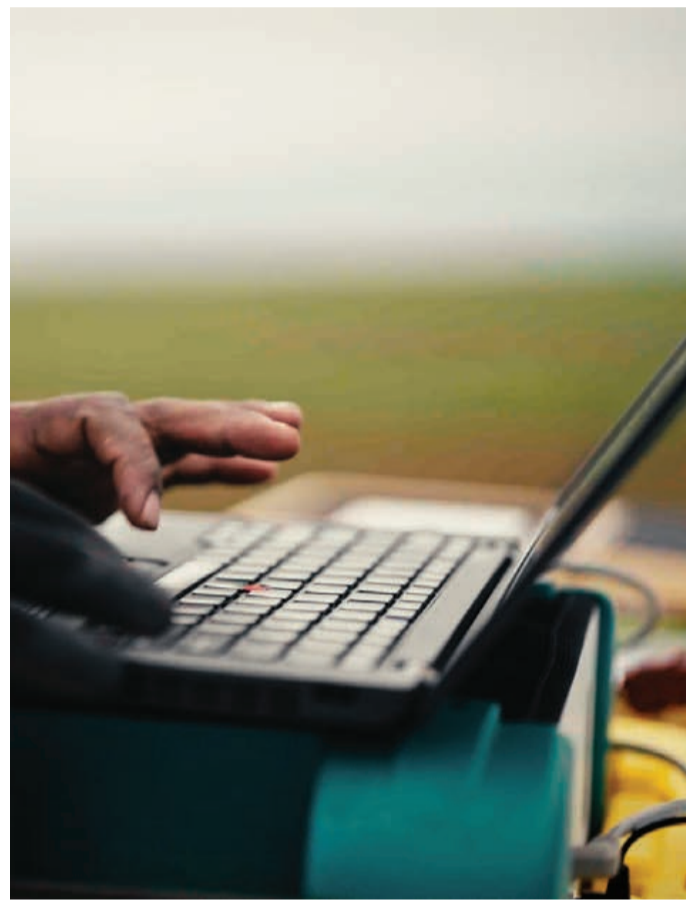
